Safety and protection measures COVID-19 Center for Photography

We are delighted to welcome visitors to the Center for Photography again! The safety and protection of our employees and visitors is our highest priority. We therefore ask you to observe the following safety and protection measures:

- Masks are compulsory in all interior and exhibition rooms of the Center for Photography. Masks are available at the reception.
- Keep a distance of one and a half metres to other visitors.
- Please wash or disinfect your hands regularly. Please find disinfection dispensers in the foyers.

Information on Public Guided Tours and Workshops

From 19.04.2021 public guided tours and workshops will take place on site again. Restrictions apply. Please note the following information:

- Public guided tours are limited to 14 participants.
- We ask you to leave your contact details (name and first name, telephone number, email address and place of residence) on a first come, first serve basis at the reception for public guided tours. The data will be destroyed after fourteen days and will only be used for contact tracing. We would like to inform you that you may be asked by the cantonal medical service to self-isolate if you were in contact with a person suffering from COVID-19 during the tour.
- Workshops in the photo lab (*Camera Obscura and Photogram*) are limited to six participants and *Cyanotype* workshop is limited to eight participants.

Information for Schools and Teachers

- There is no restriction on the number of participants for guided tours and exhibition workshops for schools (up to the age of twenty).
- Workshops in the photo lab (*Camera Obscura and Photogram*) can be booked for groups of up to six people.
- The following workshops cannot be booked at present: *Photography Today* and *Networked Photography*
- Masks are compulsory for all pupils, students and teachers.
